Rec Leagues

Total expenses is \$24357.30. We should consider putting money in savings depending on how things go at the end of the season. Consider fundraising project if not this spring, then for the fall.

Sponsors/Fundraising/Special Events

Might consider a car wash as a fundraiser. We'll need to check with the park board about detergent, water, etc. Jeremy will check with them. Perhaps raffle Indy 11 tickets? Let's try for an event on May 16th. What are some higher dollar items that we are considering: deck on the concession stand, no tip goals for the U12 fields. Park board is OK with the net for field 1. \$3475 for 90mph screen and \$2815 for 72mph screen. Jakob will probably have about \$600 of income and is applying for a Putnam County grant. Pedar will apply for a grant at WalMart as a representative of PCYSA. Board approves. Will the league be interested in funding about \$1200 for the 90mph screen? May 16th is the U10 jamboree. It is also the Indy 11 night for Putnam County. Have the younger kids walk out and play during halftime. Roger will send out an email for a lottery for the travel players. Spirit wear? Perhaps have an online ordering system?

Things are going well. Debbie has spent \$420.19, but has brought in over \$600. She is going to Sam's every week. She would like to buy more items and needs a check made out to her for items. Tiffany can do this, but perhaps we should get a membership for PCYSA. Yes, this sounds good but we need to continue to chat about it next month.
